- Restoration opportunities assessment work Bill Eisenstein shared opportunities assessment
 along the Tuolumne below the La Grange Diversion Dam to utilize up to 77 acres of flood plain
 restoration to the benefit of salmon and spawning. McBain will provide a technical assessment of
 restoration locations.
- Michael Cooke shared work comes from FERC relicensing efforts.
- Roger Masuda shared landowners willing to sell their land were granted and easement to preserve their riparian water rights.

- Seine have stopped due to temperature, noting that some devices have been lost (riffle 5).
 Total of 971 salmon were captured through June 10th.
